


Our fave Sydney activities

- Get the ferry to Manly and walk around to Shelly Beach for a swim and a snorkel. Grab lunch Queen Chow and a drink at Manly Pavillion

Our fave day trips

- Cronulla: Chloe's local beach town! Get brunch at Next Door, swim Salmon Haul, and enjoy an afternoon drink and bites at Pippi's. You can also get the ferry from Cronulla over to Bundeena for a swim!
- Blue Mountains: Get the train from Central and head to Katoomba. You can take in the views, go on a hike, or do the famous scenic railway.
- Palm Beach: Head to where 'Anyone But You' was filmed, and walk up to the lighthouse, go to the beach, have brunch at the boatshed, and get an afternoon drink at The Newport.
- Southern Highlands: Rent a car and drive down Sydney's south coast grab a pie in Berry, check out the Kangaroo Valley, and get lunch at Burrawang Pub.
- National Parks: Rent a car and check out the stunning national parks in and around Sydney with hikes, waterfalls and hidden beaches.

Leaving Sydney

- **NSW:** For a getaway that isn't leaving the state, rent a car and drive down to Hyam's Beach which holds the world record for the whitest sands in the world. Stay at Paperbark Camp for a very Aussie experience! If you want to spend a bit more, Lorde Howe Island is also spectacular
- Queensland: Cairns in Queensland is a great base for doing both the Daintree Rainforest and the Great Barrier Reef. However, our favorite spot is Hamilton Island which is a short two-hour flight from Sydney. Fitzroy Island is also beautiful and very affordable, and Byron Bay is a must-do for surfer types
- **Tassie:** Tasmania is full of rugged landscapes and stunning hiking trails, as well as famous cultural institutions like MONA
- The Outback: For a quintessential Australian experience (note: it will be HOT), head to Yularawhere the world-famous Uluru is located. If you go, be sure to have Chris (Chloe's brother who works there) fly you, who flies with Ayers Rock Scenic flights
- New Zealand is also only a three-hour flight from Sydney!
